



A draught of a Tract of land situate in Newberry Township in the County of York being parts of a larger Tract Originally granted to a certain John Heald by warr^t dated the 1st day of November 1735 & Surveyed the 4th day of the same month & returned into the Surveyor Generals Office, And now resurveyed, and two hundred & three acres and a half & allowance of 6^{as} P.C. & C. being one moiety thereof bounded and described as above laid off for the Heirs of James Todd deceased in the Proportions above described; pursuant to a Warr^t from His Excellency William Moore, President of the Supreme Executive Council of this State bearing date the 13th of March 1782. Resurveyed March 27th 1782.
