



A Draught of one hundred and ninety two acres and one hundred and fifteen perches of land with six per Cent for roads. Situate in Fermanagh township in Mifflin County, formerly Cumberland, which is part of a tract of land surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> November 1762 by William Lyon late Deputy Surveyor, in pursuance of a Warrant to Robert Guthrie dated 10<sup>th</sup> June 1762, said to contain 212<sup>a</sup> 72, but found to contain 213<sup>a</sup> 94 with 6 p Cent. Resurveyed the above part 11<sup>th</sup> Jan'y 1812, at the request of Michael Funk who appears to be in part the present owner.
