



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Richard Malone on a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two hundred and Eighty Six Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of Hurtleberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Hurtleberry Street aforesaid. Westward by River Alley. Southward by Billberry Alley. and Eastward by Lot Number Two hundred and Eighty Seven. —
 Returned into the Secretary's Office the 16th day of August 1774 for Jacob Haverling by Warrant dated the 12th day of August 1774.
