



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Manchester situate on the waters of Shamokin Creek adjoining land surveyed to Samuel Treat and about sixteen miles by estimation from Fort Augusta in Berks County containing two hundred and ninety seven acres and twenty eight perches besides the usual allowance of 6 p Cent for roads &c.
