



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for John Harris on a Certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General plan of said Town Number One hundred and Seventy six. Containing in Breadth East and West Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Blackberry Street Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and Seventy five. Northward by Barberry Alley. and Westward by River Street. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 13th day of September 1774 for John Harris Jun^r by Warrant dated the 8th Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventeenth day of FEBRUARY 1905
