



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 on a Certain Lot of Ground for Frederick Hill Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Sixty Six Containing in Breadth East and West on Blackberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Blackberry Street afores^d Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and Sixty five Northward by Barberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number One hundred and Sixty seven. Returned into the Secretarys office the 9th day of February 1775.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty seventh day of February 1905
