



In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 16th day of September 1776 requiring me to Survey and lay out for Levi Hollingsworth a certain Lot of Ground at or near the North End of the City of Philadelphia and without the Limits thereof mark'd in a General Plan of the Lots there Number thirty seven. I do hereby Certify that I did on the 24th day of September 1776 Survey and lay out the said Lot of Ground unto the said Levi Hollingsworth and find the same to be situate at the North End of the City aforesaid and without the limits of the same. Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of Callowhill Street Twenty feet, and in Length North and South Eighty feet. Bounded Northward by Callowhill Street Eastward by Lot Number Thirty Six. Southward by the Back e^d of a Second Street Lot. and Westward by Lot Number thirty eight. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 25th day of September 1776
