



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Upper Milford Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) and Province of Pennsylvania. Containing Ninety nine acres and 24 Perches of Land. together with the usual allowance at six per Cent for Roads or 105 acres and 16 Perches of Land Strict measure But said to Contain by the first Draught 97^{as} 144 perches and the allowance. That was formerly surveyed to Peter Beaver. By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries Dated the 3rd July Anno-1740 Who by his Deed Poll Dated in Hampshire County in the Province of Virginia on the 11th January Anno-1773. Sold and Conveyed all his Right to the same unto David Heimbach to whom it was resurveyed on the 24th March Anno 1773.
