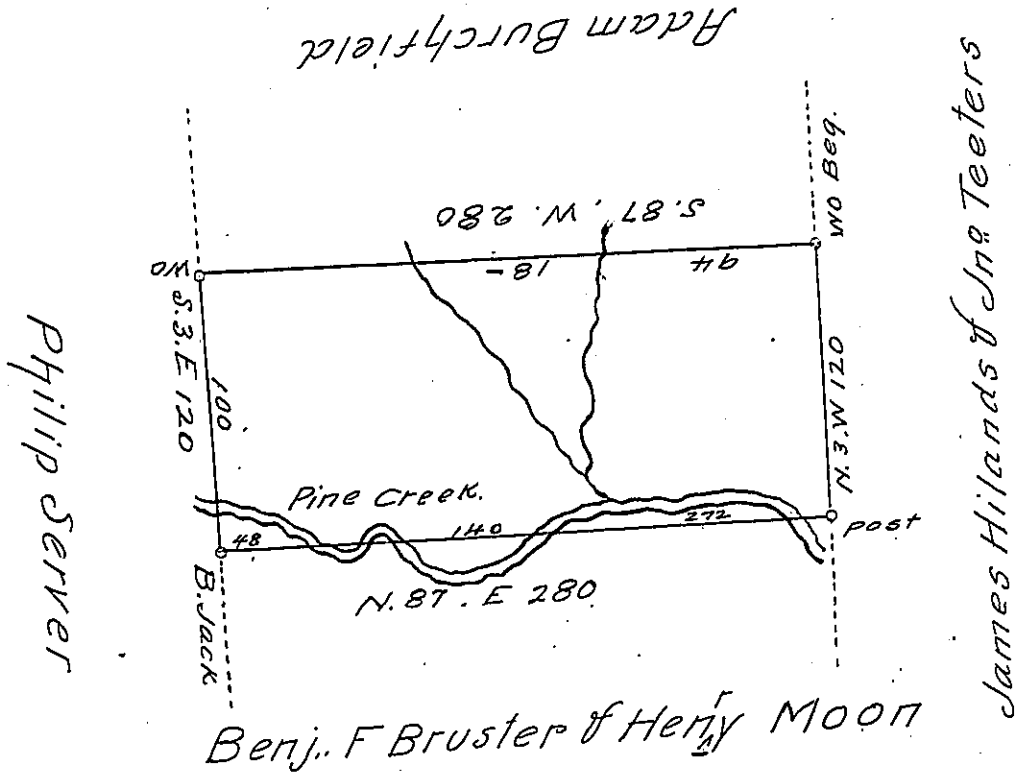

D. Coon D.S.
