



In pursuance of an Act of Assembly passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a Commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esquire Surveyor Generall for the state of Pennsylvania to me Directed bearing date at Philad^a the 14th of August 1783 the above tract of land containing two hundred & one acre one hundred and forty perches and allowance of Six pr.
