



Situate on the West side of Terrass Mountain in Colrain Township Bedford County containing four hundred and ten acres thirty six perches and allowance of six pr. Cent. for Roads &c. Originally surveyed the 12th Sept. 1794 by Henry Cassidy for George Woods D.S. on Warrant dated the 10th April 1794 granted to John Brown for 400 acres of which it is said no return has been made. Resurveyed by Robert Stewart D.S. the 20th June 1835 according to the original marks upon the ground. And again resurveyed the 12th June 1844 according to the original marks upon the ground for Samuel Williams & Abraham Kerns the present Claimants.
