



The Draught of a tract of land Situate in Haines Township Centre County Containing two hundred and Eighty three Acres. Sixty perches and allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 24th day of September 1817. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Hering in trust for the heirs of Philip Aman. Deced. dated the 14th day of May 1817.

On the above described premises, there is two improvements, and two families residing on the same, two dwelling houses and barns. about thirty Acres of Cleared land, and a number of fruit Trees of different kinds - first improved in April 1798.
