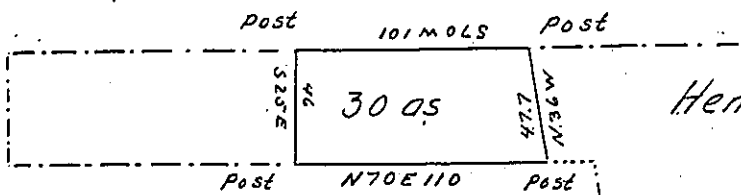

Examined the above & corrected it this 26th Oct 1844 at The request of John Norris Esqr.
