



A Draft of a tract of land, Situate in Londonderry township, Lebanon County containing Eighty-nine acres and three-quarters and allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed Jan. 5th 1850 by Samuel Hoffer Esq. and by me examined this first day of Sept. 1870. and found to be correct. Being a part of a larger tract of 340 acres, 100 perches & allowance originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Joseph Graybill dated the tenth day of May 1744.
