



SURVEYED April 22^d 1852 to John Hill Esqr. in trust for the heirs of Dr. William G. Stewart the above described tract of land situated in Wheatfield Township Indiana County containing Ninety Eight Acres & allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. bounded as above described including an improvement made by John Carnahan about the year A. D. 1818 (whose claim has been vested in William G. Stewart in his lifetime) in pursuance of a warrant dated 1st of March A. D. 1852 Granted to John Hill Esqr. in trust &c.

That part marked A is thought to be a part of a Survey made to Benjamin Lodge on the 20th day of November 1793 which overlapt the Cephas Dewess Survey which was made on the 24th day of May 1774 but the claim to it is now in the heirs of Dr. Wm G. Stewart D^s
