



A DRAUGHT of a Tract of Land Situate on the South side of Franks Town Branch of Juniata River above the Standing Stone Crossing in Cumberland County Containing three Hundred and five acres and one Hundred and Eleven perches and the usual allowance of Six Cent for Roads, Surveyed for William Hussey November 15<sup>th</sup> 1762 in Pursuance of the Honourable the Proprietaries Warrant bearing Date the 17<sup>th</sup> Day of March Anno Domini 1755.
