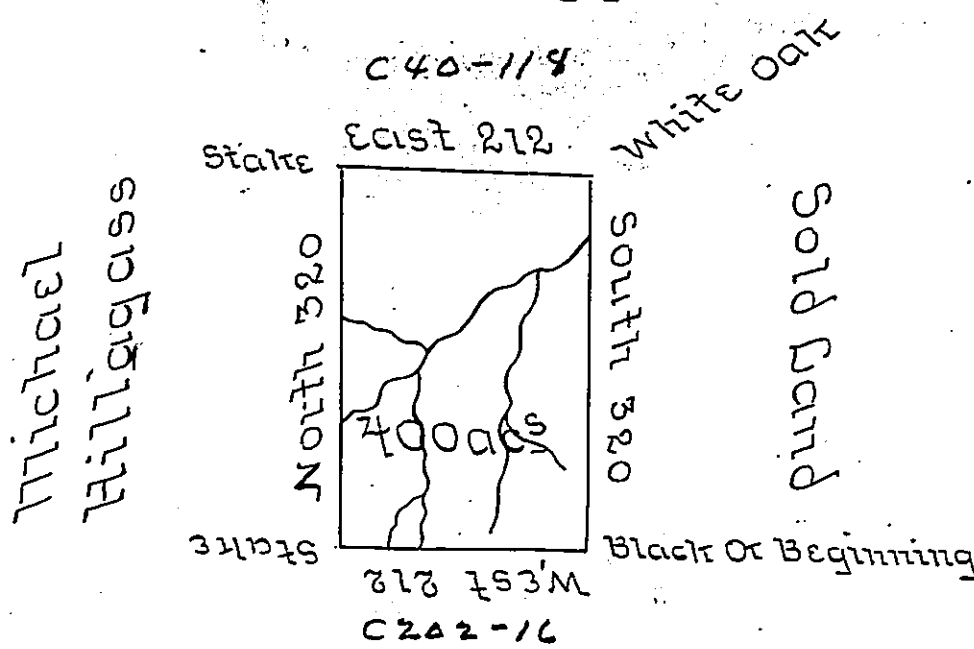

The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 5th of February 1795 - in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Henry Hillgass for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4th of January 1792. Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Concauencing Creek adjoining Land granted to Michael Hillgass called Ferry hill containing four Hundred Acres and the usual Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads
