



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Ferrimanagh Township in Cumberland County Containing one Hundred and three Acres and Sixty nine perches and the usual Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads; Surveyed for Thomas Holt September the 20th 1762 in pursuance of the Honourable the Proprietar^{ies} Warrant Bearing Date 8th June 1762.

The above Warr^t was located on Jacks Creek but could not be satisfied there by reason of prior Warrants granted to Epitain Blain & Henry Cunningham & is now Executed on the West side of Brightwells Run, on the Traders Path North Side of Juniata about five Miles above the Mouth of ~~Juniata~~ ^{Kishacoquillis} where the Land was then Vacant, so far as came to my knowledge
