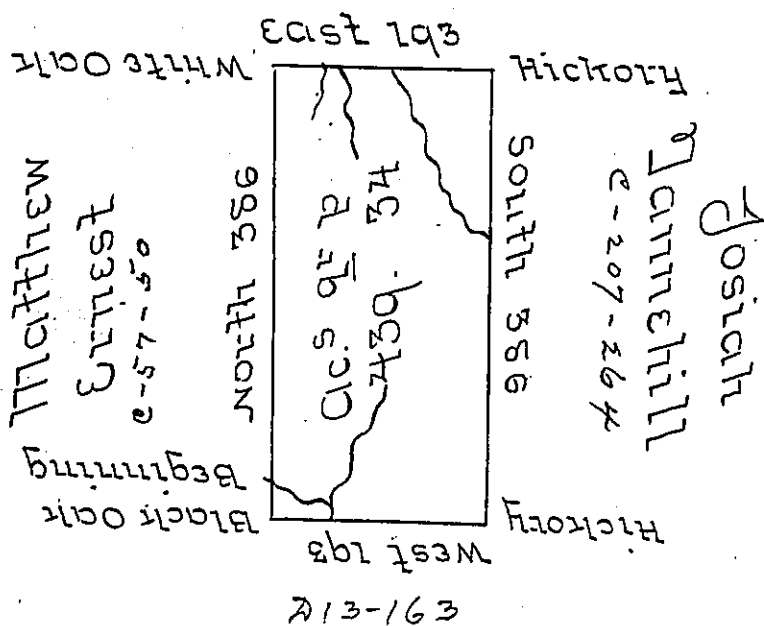

The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 22^d 1704 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Horner for 400 Acres of Land Dated February the 10th 1704 Situate Adjoining Matthew Ernest to the Eastward and on the North Side of the Large Stream which empties into Big Beaver North and West of the River Ohio in District No 9 Called Beaver flat on the Waters of Big Beaver and pine Creek Containing four hundred thirty nine Acres and thirty four Poles together with the usual Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads
