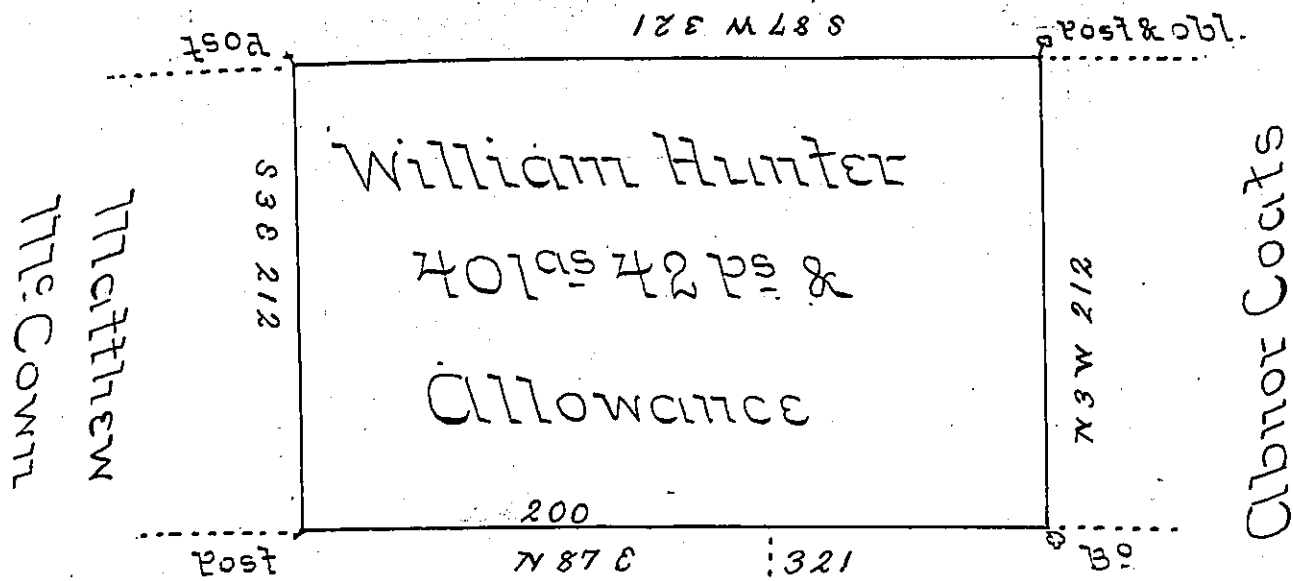


Donation lands

The above is a Draft of a Tract of Land which was surveyed to William Hunter on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of May 1805 by Virtue of his Warrant Dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1805 Containing four Hundred and one Acres & 42 perches and Allowance of six per Cent &c. Including his Actual Settlement and Improvement Situate on the waters Muddy Creek in Consequessing Township Butler County -
