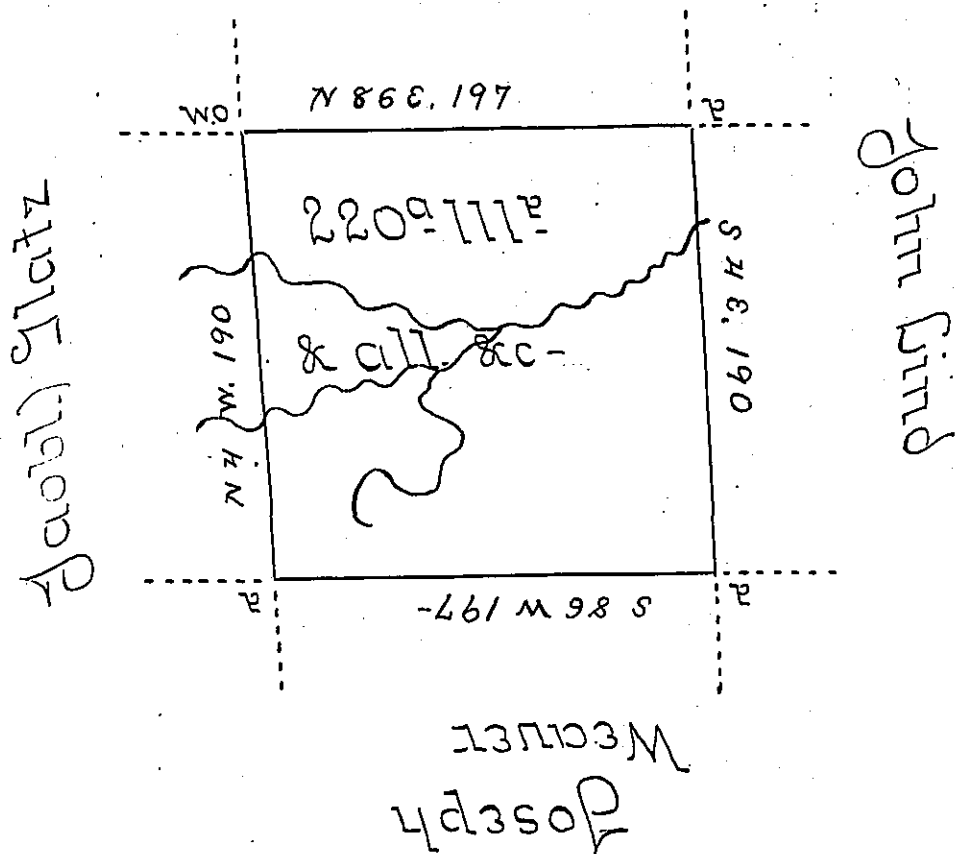


Henry Dehuff
