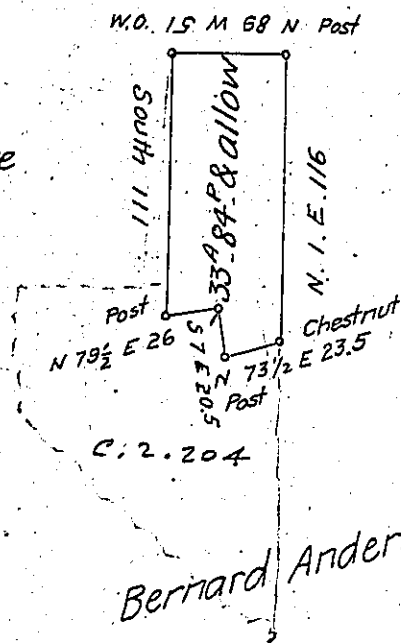

December 25th 1835 Surveyed the above described Lot or tract of land
 on a branch of Brady's Run
 Situate in South Beaver Township B-Co. on an actual settlement made by
 Peter Tedrow and transferred to John Hunter Junr. Containing thirty three
 acres and eighty-four perches and allowance of Six per cent &c. Beginning
 at a White Oak N.W. corner, adjoining lands with Griffith Evans on the
 West, Bernard Anderson on the South, John Olden on the East, and
 James Pearson, Carpenter on the North
