



By virtue of a warrant granted to John Howard dated the 20th of August 1814 there was surveyed on the 28th day of May A. Dom. 1819 (by Henry M. Richards for John V. Epler then Deputy Surveyor.) unto George Ege, Esquire in right of the said John Howard the above described tract of land situate in Heidelberg township, Berks County, containing four hundred and eight acres and the allowance of six per cent &c.
