



The above is the draught of a tract of ground called Point-pleasant situate on the waters of buffalo creech in Donegall Township, Washington County containing five acres and one hundred and nineteen poles and allowance Surveyed August 2<sup>nd</sup> 1836 in persuance of a warrant granted to Joseph Henderson for fifteen acres dated June 25<sup>th</sup> 1836 part of which land has been improved from forty to fifty years.
