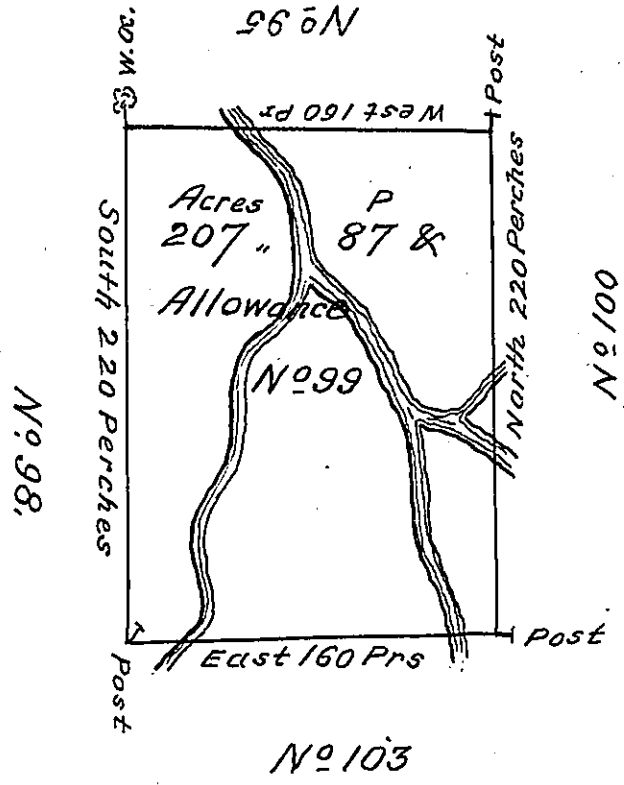

In pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12th day of March 1783 for the Sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a commission under the hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq^r. Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania to Me Directed bearing date at Philad^a the 14th of August 1783 The above tract of land Containing two hundred and Seven acres and eighty seven Perches and Allowance of Six $\frac{7}{8}$ Cent for roads & c^a was surveyed on the 30th day of June 1785 To John Lukens Esq^r by Sam^l. Nicholson Surveyor General
