executed 5th August 1780 (obl) in Pursuance of a certificate in the words

"We the Commiss^{rs} for adjusting Claims to unpatented Lands in y^e Counties of Monongalia, Yohg^a & Ohio, do hereby certify that Henry Hulse is entitled to four hundred Ac^s of Land in the County of Yohg^a on y^e Saw Mill Run to include his actual Settlement made in y^e year 1772. & also a Right in Preemption to four hundred Acres of Land adjoining thereto, Given under our H^{ds} at Cox's Fort the 17th Feby 1780. in y^e 4th year of y^e Commonwealth -
