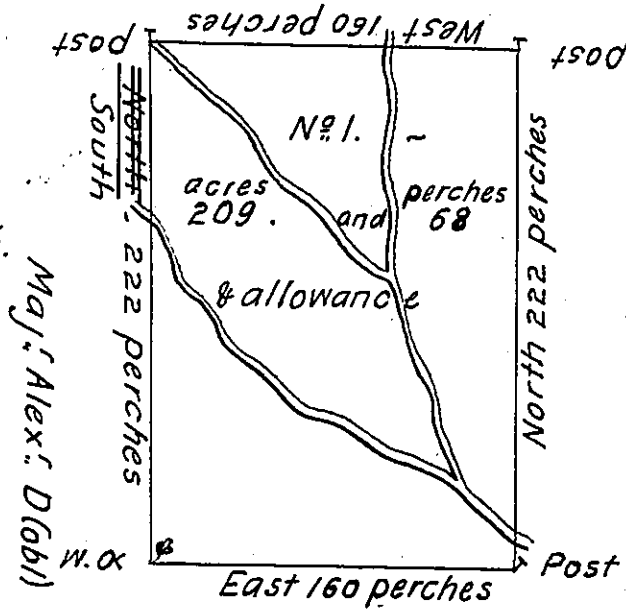


Donation Lands.

In pursuance of an act of Assembly Passed the 12th Day of March 1783 for the Sale of Certain Lands therein Mentioned and by Virtue of a Commission to me Directed under the Hand and Seal of Office of John Lukens Esq: Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philad^a. the 14th day of August 1783 the above tract of Land Containing two Hundred and Nine Acres and Sixty Eight perches and Allowance of 6 ¹/₂ Cent for roads &c was Surveyed on the 31st Day of May 1785 by
