



In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of Certain lands therein Mentioned and by Virtue of a Commission Under the hand and seal of Office from John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783. the above tract of land Containing two hundred & Sixteen acres and one hundred and fifty six Perches and allowance of 6 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> Cent for Roads &c. was Surveyed on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785 by William Alexander D: S. To John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> S. Gen<sup>l</sup>
