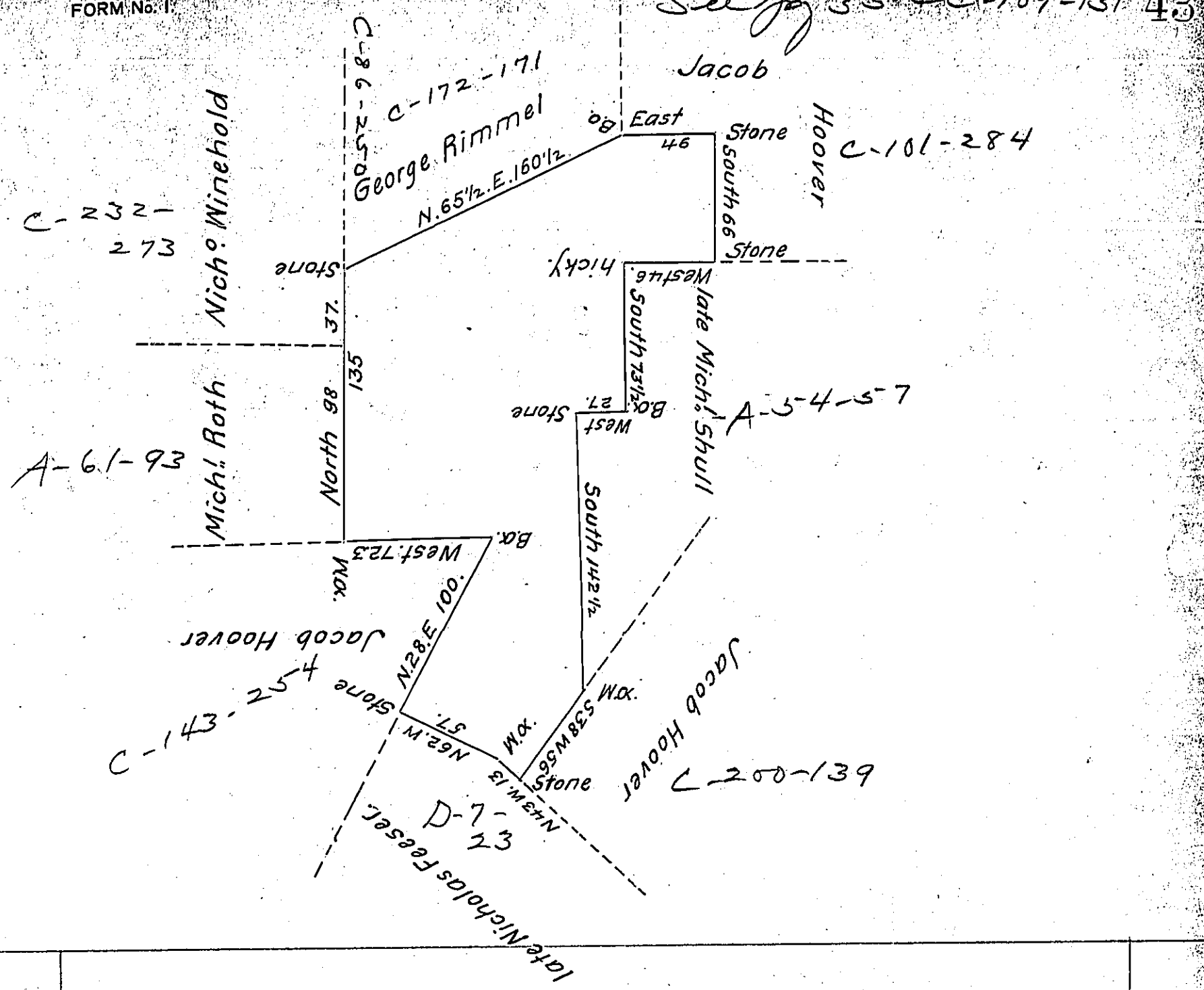

Resurveyed the 18th day of November 1783 unto Adam Helwick (According to the old lines formerly run by Benjamin Lightfoot) the above Described Tract of Land Situate in Cocolico Township Lancaster County, Containing One hundred and Ninety Seven Acres, and ~~one hundred forty three perches~~ and the usual Allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.
