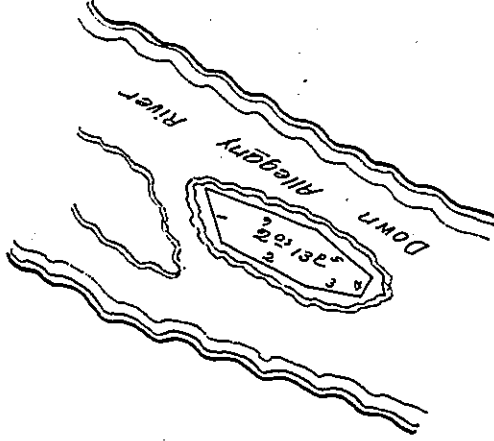

about four miles and a quarter above the mouth of Conewango Creek in War-  
ren County, surveyed 3<sup>d</sup> of February 1812, in pursuance of a Warrant granted  
to Jacob Hook. Dated January 13<sup>th</sup> 1812.
