Surveyed on an Application No 3266 dated May 2^d 1768 granted to John William Rushell - The above part resurveyed for Ephraim Hill.

Note. The above part of As 7. 114 Ps. on comparison with the Drft of the whole tract appears to differ somewhat - The Return however is now made from actual survey, and corresponding with the adjoining surveys.
