



VACANT LAND

A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Triangle situate on the south (obl.) of the West Branch of Susquehanna opposite to a remarkable Grove of Yo (obl.) Locusts adjoining and below Land of Adam Zantzinger; about 9 Mile (obl.) Lands of William Patterson Esquire and about Twelve Miles above Chinglecharn (obl.) old Town in the County of Bedford containing three hundred and fifty four (obl.) and the usual Allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent. for Roads &c. Surveyed the 30th (obl.) of June 1773 for Adam Hubley the younger in Pursuance of a Warrant granted To him Dated the 12th Day of May in the same year by
