



The above is a Draught of a survey made the 20<sup>th</sup> of May 1816 containing 200 Acres and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Johnston bearing date the 31<sup>st</sup> of July 1786 situate in Whitely—formerly Greene Township and County of Greene on the waters of Big Whitely Creek called "Gaper's-neglect" Surveyed by
