



The above described tract of one hundred and twenty three Acres and one hundred and forty nine perches and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. is part of a larger Tract of 319 Acres 52 perches & allowance, situate in Guilford Township, Franklin County; which was Surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> of October 1809 In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to James Jack. Bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 1753 Resurveyed & divided off the above part for Philip Ayler the 8<sup>th</sup> of August 1822.
