The bearings round the draft are agreeable to the Meridian of Adams County there is about two and one half acres of said land cleared and enclosed with fence about one and one half acre has been cleared about 25 years from the best information I could obtain and the one acre quiet recently and there is no improvement of any buildings on the same the balance of said land is woodland.
