above described tract of land containing four hundred & thirty six  
acres & the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c situated  
on the North Branch of Red Bank — in the late purchase made of  
the Indians East of the Allegheny River & Conewango Creek in the Town-  
ship of Dryden Jefferson County Pa. In pursuance of a warrant granted  
the said Heath for 400  $\frac{1}{3}$  A.B. filed at Harrisburgh the 22<sup>nd</sup> of May A.D.  
1870
