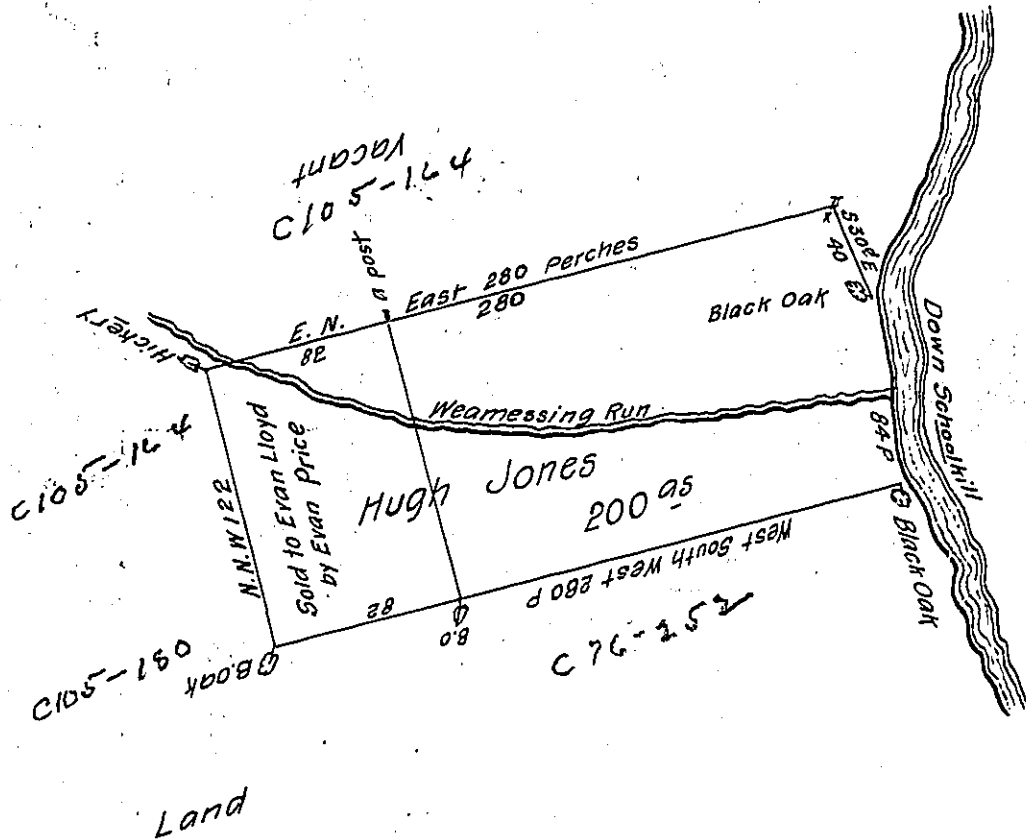

the 30th of April 1733
last past. Survey'd unto Hugh Jones, A Tract of land on the West side of
the River Schoolkill in the County of Lancaster.

Begining at a Black Oak by the S^d River, thence West South West
by Vacant Land 280 Pches to a Black Oak, thence North North West by Vacant
land 122 Pches to a Hickory, thence East North East 280 Pches to a Post
thence South 30^d East 40 Pches to a Black Oak by the S^d River, then down the
same to the Place of Begining. Containing two Hundred acres and the allowance
of Six acres P. Cent
