



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the tenth day of March 1732/3 Granted unto Hugh Jones in the County of Lancaster. The above described tract of Land was Surveyed in Cumru Township on a branch of Schuylkill— Called Angelica Run. Beginning at a Black) a Corner of the Land of Evan Loyd Thence South by the same and Vacant land 120 P &c. Containing two hundred & thirty eight acres beside the Allowance of six P. Cent.

10<sup>th</sup> day of 2<sup>d</sup> mo 1738. P- Sam Lightfoot

This land was reported to have surveyed to Hugh Jones on the first day of May 1733. by John Taylor but upon S. Lightfoot's trial of the lines at the time above mentioned they were found but run in part. he therefore completed them as above. And a Return was made thereof into the Secretary's Office on the 5<sup>th</sup> of April 1739 in w<sup>ch</sup> the Survey was reported to be made on the first of May 1733 at w<sup>ch</sup> time all the adjoining lands were vacant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventh day of April 1905.
