



Situate on the Waters of Big Soweckly Creek between the twenty fourth & twenty fifth Parallel in that Part of District No 3 to me allotted on the North side of the Ohio River being Part of the land appropriated for the Redemption of the Certificates of Depreciation &c<sup>g</sup>.
