



Situate on the waters of Laurel run adjoining land of Yost Deetz & others including an improvement first begun the 1<sup>st</sup> of March 1789 by Thomas Hutchinson in Brothers Valley township, Somerset County (late Bedford) & surveyed the 22<sup>nd</sup> Day of December 1792, by Alexander McClean, Esquire, Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of July 1792 granted to George Hoover for 100 A.S. as appears by his Official Draught thereof remaining in my Office, & Certified this 21<sup>st</sup> June 1823.
