



Situate in Shrewsbury township, in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 97⁴⁸ perches & allowance &c. Being part of a larger tract of 177⁴⁵ 139¹⁵ perches &c. of Land. Originally Surveyed in pursuance of John Hill's Application N^o. 3403, dated the 27th day of March 1769.

Resurveyed and Divided off from said larger tract of Land the 22nd day of June 1798 and now this 17th day of September 1827, the same is examined, calculated, corrected and returned for confirmation, at the request of George Henry, owner of said part.
