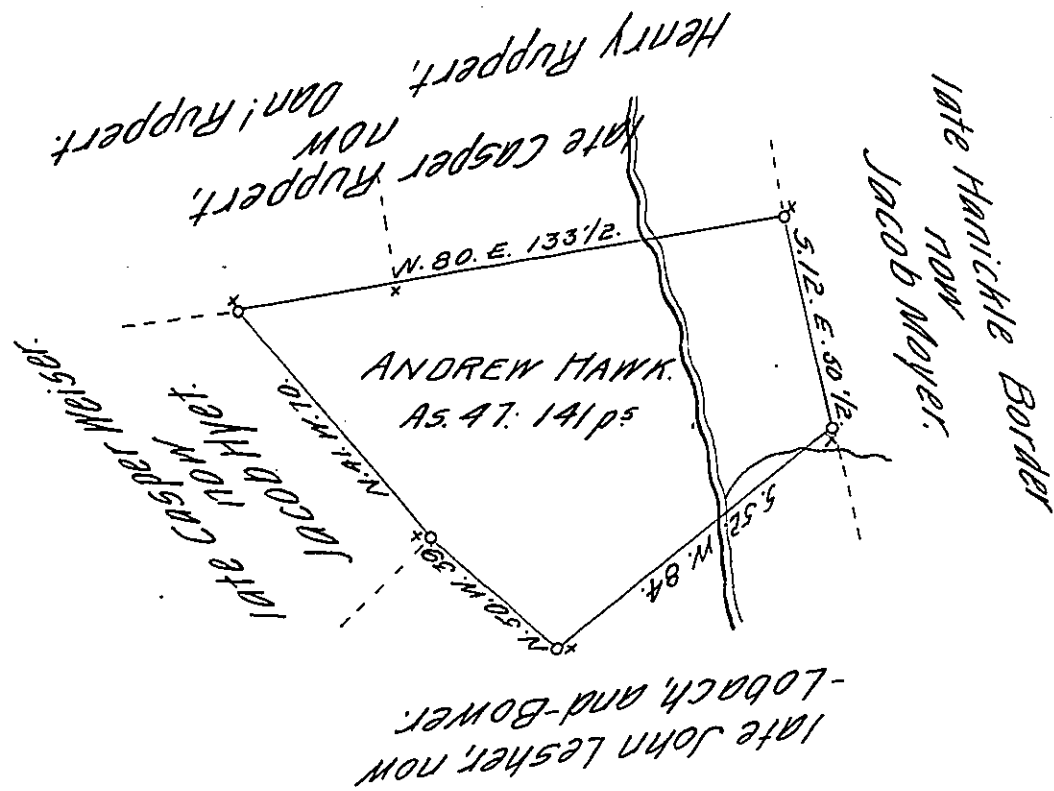


Warrant calls for Abram Leman & Casper Stiermer on Sycamore Creek, in the Long Swamp.



Situate among the Oley Hills, (now Rockland township) Berks County, Containing Forty seven acres, One hundred and forty one perches & all<sup>s</sup>. Surveyed August 18<sup>th</sup> 1763, on a Warrant dated March 7<sup>th</sup> A. D. 1758, granted to Andrew Hawk, as appears from James Scull's entries of field notes, remaining filed in my office.
