Centre County. Containing one hundred and forty seven acres
and thirty perches of allowance for Roads &c. being a part
of a larger Tract of Land Surveyed on the 2nd day of October
1771 in pursuance of an Application No 1499 dated April
3^d 1769. Granted to Mary Yearly and Resurveyed on the 31st
day of May A.D. 1844 for Jesse Hall who is the present
owner of said Land - and who directed the same to be done
according to the Original lines and Corners upon the ground
