

A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Maccony Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks.) in Pennsylvania Containing One hundred and fifty three acres and 110 perches of Land together with the usual allowance at six per Cent for Roads.

That formerly was surveyed to Ulrich Wild in pursuance of a Warrant from the Honble Proprietaries dated the 17<sup>th</sup> August Anno-1734. But the same was vacated by a Warrant granted to Henry Acker supposed to be Dated December 29<sup>th</sup> 1743 - Who sold and assigned his Right to the same on the 14<sup>th</sup> May Anno-1744 unto Michael Knappenberger.

Now Presurveyed for the said Knapperbergers Heirs on the 11<sup>th</sup> April Anno-1768.
