



By Virtue of a Warrant dated at Philadelphia on the ninth day of March Anno—1749 granted to Michael Knappenberger, the above described Tract of Land situate in Maccongy Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania.

Containing fifty four Acres of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads, was Surveyed for Jacob Tanner on the 22nd Day of November Anno—1754
