belonging to Roger Kirk being the North End of that Lot which is marked in the Original Draught of the Nottingham Lots No 14.

Originally survey'd for James Brown in the 1702. Resurvey'd in consequence of a Warrant to me directed (Granted to Isaac Hains & others concern'd) for Resurveying & Returning that part of the said Lots which lays North of the Maryland Line bearing date the 29th of Novemb: 1787. Situate part in East Nottingham & part in West Nottingham Townships in Chester County. Certify'd the 24th of the 9th mo. 1788
