



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the fourth day of October 1746 surveyed the twenty ninth day of March 1748 to Simon Heilar the above described Tract of Land situate in Saucon Township Bucks County. Containing One hundred & forty nine acres & seventy four perches with allowance of six p<sup>c</sup> G<sup>t</sup>.
