



Situate in Cummings Township County of Lycoming on and near the head of the first fork of Larrys creek and bounded as above described, Surveyed to Charles Hepburn on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of October 1839, by virtue of his warrant for 1100 acres dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of August 1830. Containing four hundred acres and sixty perches with allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
