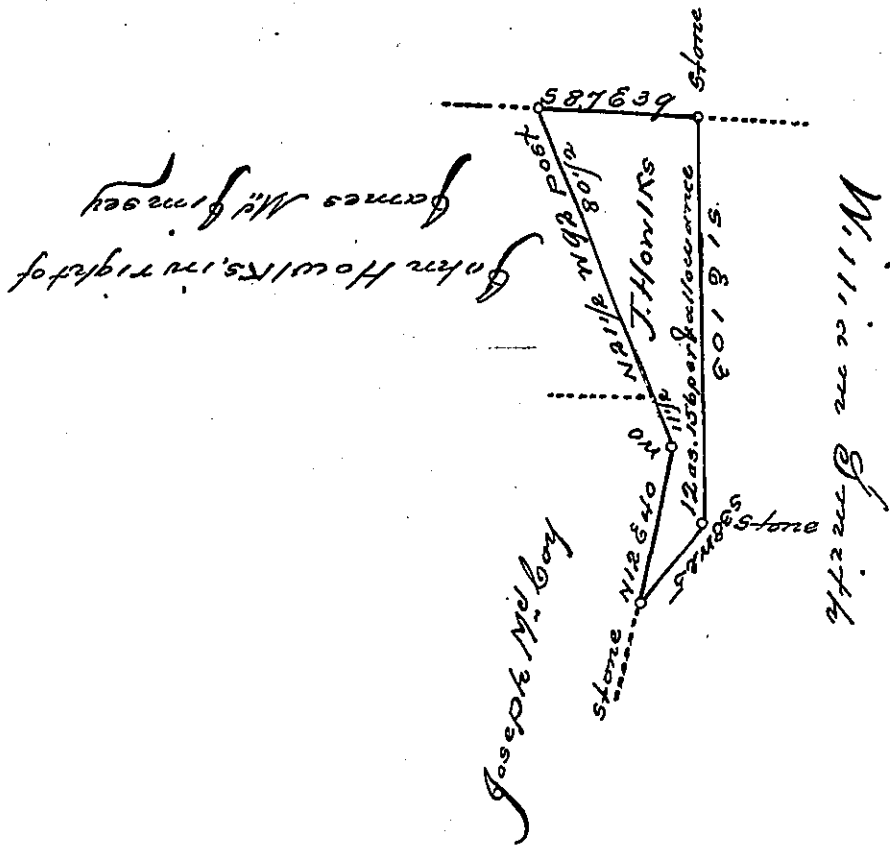


*Johnston-Holstein*
