



The Drafts of three tracts of land Situate in Greenwood Township Cum-berland County Surveyd and connected the 27th Sept: 1816 in pursuance of an Order from the Honorable the Board of Property dated the 5th August 1816.

Mr. Hummell states that all the above three tracts, was Surveyd on his two Warrants dated the 6th June 1774. If so the Surveys must have been burnt in Genl Armstrongs office or been miss laid as they are not to be found in this office. John Stayleys Warrant dated the 6th August 1792 Daniel Hains Warrant dated the 1st August 1814
